

## NOTICE OF DETERMINATION CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE MODULE 1 - HM TREASURY

- 1. On 7 September 2022, I designated HM Treasury as a Core Participant in Module 1. At the same time, I designated Michael Cockings of the Government Legal Department as its qualified lawyer in relation to this Module.
- 2. Following Mr Cockings' departure from the Government Legal Department, on 24 October 2022 I designated Armen Adjemian as HM Treasury's legal representative in relation to this Module.
- 3. On 12 January 2023, the Inquiry was informed that Mr Adjemian would shortly be leaving the Government Legal Department's COVID-19 Public Inquiry Team and that Robyn Smith would be acting as HM Treasury's legal representative in relation to this Module.
- 4. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that HM Treasury has appointed Robyn Smith as its qualified lawyer, I designate Ms Smith as its recognised legal representative in Module 1 in accordance with Rule 6(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006.
