## **Objectives**

- 1. To support the CCG by implementing strategic decisions on developing the Welsh Government role in emergency preparedness in Wales.
- 2. To consider the development of resilience at the UK level and in Wales and assess its implications for the Welsh Government.
- To consider issues and submit papers for consideration by the CCG and for possible discussion by the Wales Resilience Forum, Joint Emergency Services Group and the Wales CONTEST Board.
- 4. To implement the commitment required by Departments to the Welsh Government's work in developing resilience in Wales.
- 5. To act as a means of integrating Departments into the mainstream resilience work and to provide a closer working relationship between Departments which is required in any response to emergencies.
- 6. To provide support to the Emergency Co-ordination Centre (Wales) during an emergency, where appropriate, on behalf of the relevant Department and the sector for which that Department has responsibility.
- 7. To support the CCG in developing a recovery and regeneration strategy in the aftermath of an emergency through the Welsh Government Recovery Support Arrangements.
- 8. To consider annual training and exercise programmes for the Welsh Government to be agreed by the CCG.
- 9. To bring together Welsh Government leads on Critical National Infrastructure (CNI) and the work being taken forward by the Centre for the Protection of National Infrastructure (CPNI).
