The UK Review Board has now reconvened and there is a real focus on ensuring our pandemic preparedness is fit for purpose, not least because it remains the top UK risk. Against that background, I am intending to call a meeting of the Welsh Government Pandemic Flu Preparedness Group during either the third or fourth week of February. At that meeting, I hope we can update you on the situation across the work streams and also cover the current position with LRF Pandemic Flu Plans. On the matter of LRF Pandemic Flu Plans, I would be grateful if you would send me a copy of your current LRF pandemic flu plan. I know that some of you are already reviewing your pandemic plans which is sensible. I am sure we are all mindful of the coronavirus outbreak and although we are not in a pandemic response situation, there may be elements of our pandemic planning that we may need to call before the situation diminishes so we need our plans to be as up to date as possible. It is important that all 4 Chairs of the LRF Pandemic Flu Groups attend or are represented so could you please provide dates of availability in the last two weeks of February to my colleague NR @gov.wales), who will confirm arrangements.
