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[16/11/2020, 20:50:43] Martin Reynolds: As you agreed with the Leader, he today confirmed to the Commons the intention for clinically extremely vulnerable MPs to be able to participate virtually in substantive Chamber business (i.e. debates on legislation). If MPs agree the motion, it should take effect from next week until end March 2021 (as with other Covid adjustments). It will not apply to Westminster Hall which must be in person due to House resourcing issues.

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[17/11/2020, 19:29:10] Martin Reynolds: Given Irrelevant & Sensitive that physical voting is down to reduced numbers, you – along with other members of the Cabinet and 200 of our MPs – have applied for a proxy vote (we did it for you). Stuart Andrew, the Deputy Chief Whip, will vote on your behalf. Whilst this is in place you do not and should not be physically voting. It can be suspended if we need you to physically vote at any time. It will also increase your voting figures.

We are proposing weekly meetings chaired by you, which then feed into more detailed COVID O sessions chaired by CDL to implement your steers and conduct assurance. We will produce a regular set of key performance indicators for you and put the most important ones in the COVID dashboard. At the right time, you will also want to stress-test on specific deep-dive topics, e.g. workforce or IT, and we will bring in external experts to help with this as required.

CX, MHCLG SoS, BEIS SoS and Lord Chancellor have agreed to extend the moratorium for a final three months, to protect businesses and jobs over Christmas. Ministers are clear the moratorium must end by 31 March and parties should use this time to negotiate. MHCLG will announce the extension on 9 December, and will point to previously agreed measures, e.g. the Code of Practice, to encourage negotiation between landlords and tenants through this final quarter. MHCLG will also announce a review of the commercial landlord and tenant relationship (focusing on the Landlord & Tenant Act 1954 Part II), subject to final agreement from the legislation team.

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[10/12/2020, 20:19:48] Martin Reynolds: ECB announced their latest policy decisions today which include increasing the size of its pandemic emergency purchase programme by €500bn to at least March 2022, taking it to €1,850bn and keeping interest rates unchanged. They have also stated they expect a weaker recovery next year at only 3.9% down from 5% although a stronger pick-up in 2022 of 4.2% growth.

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[12/04/2021, 20:46:38] Martin Reynolds: Brazil has the second highest number of Covid-19 cases and deaths (after the United States). 56,000 people died of Covid-19 during March 2021 and as greater numbers of the very elderly receive the vaccine, a higher proportion of hospital admissions come from younger sections of the population. This morning, a Brazilian study of ICU admissions reported that 52.2% of ICU patients during March were aged 39 or younger. There is no clear explanation for the higher proportion of young people in ICU, but up to this point, Brazil's vaccine rollout has focused on vaccinating the very elderly and the proportion of patients over 80 in Brazil's ICUs fell from 13.6% to 7.8% during March. As our vaccine rolls out, the total number of people in hospital should fall, but we should expect the young, unvaccinated population to make up a greater share of that total.
