Grateful if you could include the below in the box tonight.

PM,

To be aware the Chinese government granted the permission for the flight to evacuate British nationals from Wuhan. The flight will arrive at Brize Norton at 1045am tomorrow. On arrival the British nationals will be transferred to Arrowe Park Hospital, where they will be kept in isolation for 14 days. There will also be a number of foreign nationals on the flight. The Spanish Government has agreed the onward transfer of these foreign nationals directly from Brize Norton to Spain on the same charter aircraft (the aircraft is chartered from a Spanish company).

The Chinese government has also now confirmed that dual nationals can travel on the flight. The FCO will see if there is still time to get dual nationals on this flight, otherwise they will look to seek places on upcoming European flights.

The WHO is expected to declare a Public Health Emergency of International Concern today. Once that happens, the UK will increase the threat level to the UK public from low to moderate.
