NIHR just launched a research call for longer term impacts of COVID-19- <https://www.nihr.ac.uk/covid-19/funding-longer-term-recovery-and-learning-research.htm>

This aims to better understand and manage the health and social care consequences of the global COVID-19 pandemic beyond the acute phase. Research should focus specifically on health outcomes, public health, social care and health service delivery and to mitigate the impact of subsequent phases and aftermath.

There are two deadlines for applications in the first instance. However, additional deadline dates may be added in due course depending on demand and the trajectory of the pandemic.

- First closing date: Tuesday 23 June 2020 by 1pm
- Second closing date: Tuesday 14 July 2020 by 1pm

Projects are expected to start within four weeks of award notification.

Hi both

SoS has made us aware that he spoke to CMO a few weeks ago and asked him to commission NIHR to do some research into post viral fatigue and the long term impacts of COVID. He is concerned that there is increasing evidence that some people may continue to experience symptoms for months after they caught the disease. He thinks that as the number of acute cases in hospitals falls, this will become an increased focus.

Can you confirm that NIHR are taking this forward? SoS is keen for an update and would like to say something about this work publicly soon (as early as this week if possible).
