CNO view - if move to opening care homes to admissions when positive cases, it'll need additional staff to care only for isolated patients and use associated IPC processes

TELP - treatment escalation and limitation plan

ICU - detailed capacity planning in London

- mutual aid / new supplies / staffing

- oxygen supply

- London - fears on surge - higher than those modelled in SPI-M

- 799 $\rightarrow$ 7642 (but also requires a build as well as surgery within existing capacity)

- London likely to breach current capacity within 7-10 days

- worries about continuing household spread & nosocomial spread

- rest of country 1-2 weeks behind

- R_0 2.6 - 2.8 (based on observed deaths)

- Doubling time - 3-4 days

- no way of currently measuring R_0 value in community to measure effectiveness of measures

Random swabbing of symptomatic individuals for true infection rate in community:

SPI-M to give view on what further testing measures desirable to give further adverse warning

CMO CALL

- WHO - general view that was seen unhelpful; Test Test Test being a particular example of misrepresentation
- SAGE - masks
 - likely to recommend
