

- Update on SitRep re:patient follow up

RCWS

- Assess key strands of a response
- We are thinking about our departmental model for how we deal with things that last over long periods of months - i.e. looking at what was used before 2009 (flu), 2014 (ebola)
- Emma Reed shared discussion she had with [PD] who suggested 3 different scenarios:
 1. Contained w/n EPRR and growing
 2. EU exit model - all parts of department are affected
 3. All of the department fix this issue as it becomes a global pandemic
- Other departments should look to think about how we would scale up
- PHE are currently looking to escalate already will be sharing
- [PD] will push this through SPI-M, the need to think about scaling up
- We need to communicate what we will deprioritise
- NHSE - have increased numbers to the incident, looking at supply chain and exhaustion of personnel
- DA's
 - Scots - Scottish government resilience room stood up and Health resilience hub standing up on Thurs
 - Can we do more about conveying what the worst case scenario could look like - this is not just an issue that impact health depts it will impact all depts
 - JVT - we need to think about medicines that we might need, repurposing of medicines from other areas and the proportion of ever cases where we do not have adequate data from China. Surge plans for intensive care respiratory supply and what will happen with an increase in demand
 - Welsh gvnt - a steer coming from the centre could be quite helpful
 - Ni - Similar to Scotland, issue was raised at the executive meeting they had
- Emergency powers bill - part of our pan flu toolkit it doesn't mean that we will use it
- JVT - some suggestions mortality may be a little lower than 2.5%, not as high
- Paper to NERVTAG - has been flagged to JVT

Contact tracing

- Where should we draw the line regarding contact tracing exercise
- JVT and Sharon to have a chat with Nick re: contact tracing - a conversation to agree governance
- They checked into the apartment, there was one cleaner (*under active follow-up*)
