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Dear Gregor

Please see below the formal advice from the NIMT held today;

1. <u>Moving down a level</u> compared to current assessment - Advice to CMO to move down to Level 1 from Level 2 for all three Island Boards and for Highland LA (Argyll & Bute LA from NHS Highland to remain in Level 2). In addition the move to Level 1 from Level 2 of the Moray LA within NHS Grampian. Consensus support for the move from Level 2 to Level 1 conditional on reinforcement about domestic travel and the importance that may have for the introduction of infection to other areas that have had a low incidence. The NIMT noted the additional commentary from FM in the Scottish Parliament on 27/10/20 re additional transitional arrangements for those LA moving down to Level 1 - if a

decision is taken this week to move any area to level 1, the current prohibition on meeting anyone from other households in our own home should remain in place for a period as an extra precaution.

- 2. <u>Moving up a level</u> compared to current assessment NHS Tayside (Local Authority areas of Dundee City alone) should move up to Level 3 from Level 2.
- 3. <u>Staying at the same level</u> compared to current assessment Advice to the CMO that both of NHS Lanarkshire LA's (North and South Lanarkshire) should remain at Level 3. Whilst both North Lanarkshire and South Lanarkshire have been scored as a Level 4 from the threshold data their current position appears to be improving. Whilst consideration was given to move down from Level 3 to Level 2 for both East Lothian LA within NHS Lothian and Inverclyde LA within NHS GGC the consensus was that these should remain within Level 3 but would be subject to review.
- a. Level 4 No current LA in level 4
- b. Level 3 Retention Advice to CMO that all other Level 3 LA remain at this level
- c. Level 2 Retention Advice to CMO that all other LA not already discussed remain at this level
- d. Level 1 No current LA in level 1
- e. Level 0 No Current LA in level 0

The evidence base behind the advice is currently being prepared and will be shared for publication following further consideration.
