#### **ACTIONS**

- SECRETARIAT to ensure that all departments, including the Devolved Administrations, are provided with a copy of the NSA/DH Permanent Secretary progress letter of 21 September.
- 2. PUBLIC HEALTH ENGLAND to ensure that the Exercise Cygnus lessons learnt report is uploaded on to ResilienceDirect.
- 3. HER MAJESTY'S PRISONS AND PROBATION SERVICE to liaise with the DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH and NHS ENGLAND to ensure partnering on the work to develop health and community care resilience of prisons during a pandemic. A fuller update to be provided at the next PFRB.
- 4. ALL DEPARTMENTS who have not returned the pandemic flu comms template are to ensure that this is returned promptly to <a href="Name Redacted">Name Redacted</a> @dh.gsi.gov.uk. This is also an action from the previous PFRB.
- 5. ALL DEPARTMENTS to produce a list of all their existing documents relating to pandemic influenza that are in the public domain **by Friday 20 October** and send them (including nil returns) to Name Redacted @cabinet-office.x.gsi.gov.uk.This is also an action from the previous PFRB.
- 6. CABINET OFFICE to engage with GO SCIENCE, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH and PUBLIC HEALTH ENGLAND when preparing the forthcoming advice to CABINET OFFICE Ministers on the moral and ethical workstream.
- 7. DH COMMS in conjunction with PUBLIC HEALTH ENGLAND to give consideration to what options there are to more pro-actively engage and strategically capitalise on the ongoing BBC/Cambridge University study on pandemic influenza.
