- 17. The Minister of Finance raised the Executive's response to the COVID 19 pandemic, and proposed to the Executive that a plan to close schools be included in a package of measures agreed by the Executive.
- 18. There being no consensus evident, the Executive voted on the Minister of Finance's proposal. The deputy First Minister, and the Ministers of Finance, Communities and Infrastructure voting for; and the First Minister, the Ministers for the Economy, Education, Agriculture Environment and Rural Affairs, Health

and Justice voting against, the Minister of Finance's proposal was not agreed by the Executive.

19. The Executive voted on a proposal by the First Minister that the closure of schools should be handled in accordance with the Chief Medical Officer's advice. The First Minister, the Ministers for the Economy, Education, Agriculture Environment and Rural Affairs, and Health voting for; and the deputy First Minister, and the Ministers of Finance, Communities and Infrastructure voting against, the First Minister's proposal was agreed by the Executive. The Minister of Justice did not vote on the First Minister's proposal.
