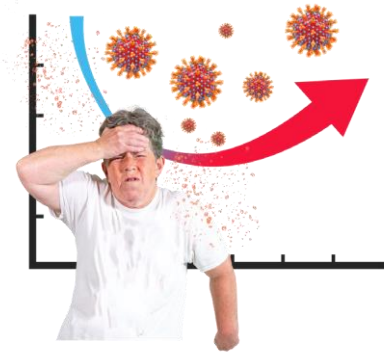

We have heard from, for example

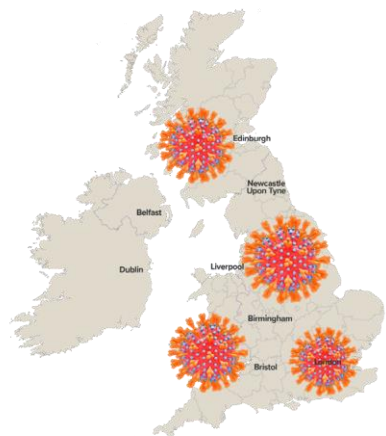
- local people and experts from across Scotland, during 3 weeks of **hearings** in Edinburgh

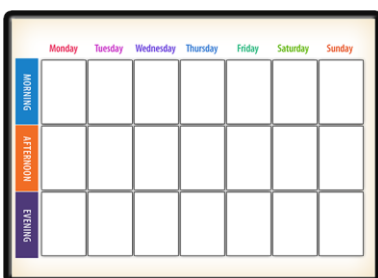
