

**TERMS OF REFERENCE
HSC SILVER
COVID-19 (containment phase)**

These Terms of Reference will be reviewed as necessary given the requirements associated with COVID-19

1.0 PURPOSE	<p>The Health and Social Care Board (HSCB), Public Health Agency (PHA) and Business Services Organisation (BSO) seek assurance on HSC preparedness to manage a response to emergency incidents in adherence to the Circular HSC (PHD) Communication 1/2010, <i>Emergency Preparedness for Health and Social Care Organisations (2010)</i> and within the context of the requirements of the Civil Contingencies Framework for Northern Ireland (2011).</p> <p>The role of HSC Silver is to provide a coordinated approach to ensure there is an appropriate and proportionate level of preparedness across the health and social care sector to enable an effective public health and HSC response to COVID-19. In doing so it will oversee work with a range of key stakeholders, including: the other UK countries; the Republic of Ireland; independent health and social care providers and those with responsibility for port health.</p>
2.0 Authority	<p>HEALTH SILVER operates under the authority of the Chief Executive PHA/HSCB, (see section 7.0) with the support of the Chief Executive BSO. Health Silver will draw on the Northern Ireland Infectious Disease Incident / Outbreak Plan (September 2018) and Joint Response Emergency Plan (April 2018) as appropriate and as drawn up by HSCB, PHA and BSO.</p>

8.0 PHA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Along with HSCB jointly leading the co-ordination of the HSC response (due to the specifics of this incident at this stage of the response the PHA will be the lead organisation (ref JREP Activation Procedure) • Jointly running the Emergency Operations Centre with the HSCB • Provide joint HSCB/ PHA SitRep to DOH • Maintain surveillance systems of COVID-19 cases and outbreak investigation • Adapt guidance on the management of cases and their contacts in light of emerging information on the virus, the clinical illness and the impact on society and services • Provide timely and accurate information for the public and health professionals on COVID-19 and the clinical effects of the infection • Provide advice on when to cease measures to slow transmission of the virus, if they have been commenced • Lead on the health protection response to COVID-19 and chair the Health Protection Sub-group • Lead the Case Management Cell • Undertake community surveillance, sero-incidence surveillance and severe disease (hospital-based) and mortality surveillance • Facilitate delivery of the COVID-19 communications programme
