ACTIVATION OF MILITARY AID TO CIVIL AUTHORITY (MACA) IN RELATION TO TRANSFER OF A PATIENT WITH COVID-19 TO A HIGH CONSEQUENCE INFECTIOUS DISEASE (HCID) UNIT

I wish to inform you that I have approved a decision to activate Military Aid to Civil Authority (MACA) to transfer a patient who has tested positive for COVID-19 to a High Consequence Infectious Disease (HCID) Unit in England.

Transfer of this patient has been discussed and agreed by clinicians here and in the specialist unit. There are no beds with the agreed specification available in NI and there are no commercial providers who currently have the appropriate equipment to transfer the patient therefore instigation of the MACA is the only option available.
