## **CHANGE IN RECOGNISED LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE**

## MODULE 3 - THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF ANAESTHETISTS, THE FACULTY OF INTENSIVE CARE MEDICINE AND THE ASSOCIATION OF ANAESTHETISTS

- On 18 January 2023, I designated the Royal College of Anesthetists, the Faculty of Intensive Care Medicine and the Association of Anaesthetists as Core Participants in Module 3 as a collective group ("the Core Participant Group").
- 2. On 28 March 2023, I designated Sonia Campbell of Mischon de Reya LLP as its qualified lawyer in relation to Module 3.
- 3. On 1 May 2024, the Inquiry was informed that Amanda Gray of Mischon de Reya LLP would be taking over from Sonia Campbell as the Core Participant Group's legal representative in relation to this Module.
- 4. Accordingly, as I am satisfied that the Core Participant Group has appointed Amanda Gray as its qualified lawyer, I designate Ms Gray as its recognised legal representative in Module 3 in accordance with Rule 6(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006.
