More restr last week, now all of NT.

How long will these restr last? More restr needed?

Plea - restr on economic activity - really long-term impact - making a living, mental health.

Clear messaging - meeting in home, not hospitality sector, businesses.

Doh Geographical location - some decrease.

Clear messaging from Govt as a whole, support available.

Don't know how long, or if it will be enough - doubt it, so paper - bunch of options.

Govt - messaging

CMO / CSF concern re opening of pubs. Look at current

possibilities.

Chair CSA flag up concerns re opening of wet pubs — transmission of virus. Economic need. Opening of wet pubs will lead to spread of virus.

Additional mitigations — curfew for wet pubs + other parts of hospitality sector. No live music, quiet background music.

Restrict table size to 6, 2 households max.

Reduce risk — recognize other issues at play re opening

DOF Agree — apply across all of 6 counties.

Correct approach.

Messaging difficult — opening of wet pubs.

But agree shd open — curfew. Transmission in home settings — need to be v clear.

Future menu — events being planned eg Holy Communion next w/e.

Future restrictions — closing hours — need to give enough notice.

Donegal, Galway - problem areas

DOH Not events themselves - social interaction afterwards - 2 Christenings, house hold transmission.

If we publish - [Scotland, England] Road-map in reverse.

Will talk to F... I this pm - Donegal / South concern.

Increase in South - close to BT60 - cross-border transmission, social events.

DNAERA - Test / track / trace?
Admission of failure.

DOH Hitting 85% of contacts -
three-fold / secondary contacts
- backdoor contacts - 7 days.
It is working - bringing more people forward for testing.

CSA People in England - not self-isolating I.

DNAERA Reluctance - targeting those who break laws. England - fine up to £10,000. West of

Province, low incidence of COVID - looking at people in towns breaking rules - but still having regs imposed. We do nothing to stop people who do not obey laws - grossly unfair.

DOH Agree - not approach we want to take. But spreading - Strabane, Enniskillen, L-derry. Enforce^m of restrictions - asked for enforce^m sub-grp of Exec. Complaints across water - fines for non-violation - will stop people coming forward for testing.

DASRA Holy Land last week - then going home + spreading.
What are we doing to sanction bad behaviour?
