Increase - hospitals, ICU

Yesterday 260+ in hosp, [ ] in ICU

Availability of ICU beds - BHS Trust - next floor of tower block, more capacity.

Significant decrease - Derry/Strabane - was 900+, now 600+ per 100,000 - still high.

Summary figures in R paper.

Current trends - over 1000 new cases per day - level of increase is slowing, no of cases will fall - less demand for tests for.

School-age children - checking on reason for reduction.

Testing = 30 per 1000 of population, higher than R0T.

Positivity rising but starting to plateau / peak.

Hospital admissions - hopefully near peak, expect to fall next week.

Similar to wave 1.

Peak - inpatients  $\rightarrow$  <sup>within</sup> next week

$$R = 1.3$$

R for cases falling = 1 today.

Indication of early impact.

Slide - Derry/STIC - highest incidence in NI.

Every part of NI - over 100 per 10000 - high in absolute terms.

Fall-off of cases in Derry/Strabane - result of restrictions

R - fell in Derry/STIC - now below 1, close to 0.7.

Slide - impact of sectors making small contributions e.g. close contact sector - slide shows impact on no of cases - much lower than otherwise.
