Social Monitoring Report – Monday 2nd November

• The majority of inbound messages to Welsh Government accounts were related to the firebreak regulations, in particular in relation to the announcement that England will enter a four-week lockdown on 5 November. Much of the discussion centred on what England's measures mean for Wales. There was also discussion about the economy, in particular the financial impact on businesses and employees of both the firebreak and England's lockdown, as well as testing.

Topic mentions in Wales:

- Firebreak The majority of messages were from individuals asking how the
 new measures set to come into force in England will affect the firebreak in
 Wales. There were some messages praising Welsh Government for acting
 sooner than England to introduce tight measures to control the virus, however
 some also suggested that Wales has not taken enough action in light of
 England's longer lockdown.
- Economy Discussion again centred on what England's new lockdown will
 mean for Wales, particularly for Welsh businesses. Some were worried that
 English businesses being close will affect supply chains for Welsh
 businesses. Others also discussed the extension of the furlough scheme, as
 well as what help will be provided by Welsh Government to the tourism
 industry.
- Testing There continues to be scepticism from some individuals regarding
 the way in which deaths from Covid-19 are recorded and reported. There
 were also a number of messages calling on Welsh Government to improve
 testing and tracing to avoid further lockdowns after the firebreak period ends.

Snapshot of other top issues

Firebreak
