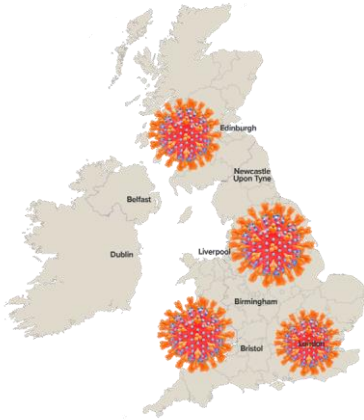




# About the Inquiry


