- Across the UK, the restrictions we have all put in place are generally focused on reducing spread of coronavirus through social interactions, aiming to allow ongoing education and business activities. We may need to introduce further controls, and many of these would have economic consequences
  - Restrictions on business activity will require HM Treasury intervention through financial support. [this is the subject of Scottish Government – PM correspondence last week – attached]
- NPIs need to be considered in the round:
  - Local controls in areas of high risk should include restrictions to travel into areas on lower risk

- Restrictions to pub licencing hours are more effective with off-licence and supermarket restrictions on sale of alcohol
