A few other thoughts on the paper (referencing the attached version – not sure if this is the most recent):

Page 1 para 3 – possibly replace 'biggest' with 'acute and serious', e.g. obesity is an enormous public health problem – it is just not as 'immediate and visible' so does not attract the same level of attention ( and it's interesting that there appears to be a relationship between the two).

Para 1.5 – suggest delete 'only' in the last sentence

Para 1.20 – first sentence suggest 'The pandemic *and the measures we have had to put in place to reduce virus transmission* will cause severe social and economic damage'.

Para 2.5 – second last sentence, similar amendment suggested 'However, the pandemic *and the measures put in place to control it* will also cause severe social and economic damage *as well as other detrimental impacts on health*.'

Para 3.2 – bullet 2 – suggest replace 'test, track and trace....' with 'trace and test those who have had contact with someone infected with coronavirus'

Para 5.2 suggest add a sentence about the need to balance this against the significant impacts on society, economic and health from the control measures themselves.
