FINAL EXECUTIVE PAPER: COVID 19 – INDICATIVE TIMELINE, EXECUTIVE RATIFICATIONS

I welcome your proposal that spectators should be able to attend outdoor sports events from 24 July as this will permit spectators at horse racing and outdoor equestrian events. I consider there to be a strong case for a similar approach to be taken in respect of indoor equestrian activities and events.

I am satisfied that this would involve a low risk of disease transmission; indoor equestrian centres are generally large well ventilated spaces were social distancing can easily be facilitated.

I note your intention to bring forward separate advice on spectators for indoor sports and would urge you to do this at the earliest opportunity.
