COVID-19 RECOVERY GROUP TERMS OF REFERENCE 29 JULY 2020

Purpose

The strategic advisory and co-ordinating group for the recovery phase of the COVID-19 pandemic, providing the Executive with advice and data to enable the Executive to take effective decisions in leading a recovery process that is joined up across the whole of Government.

Role

- To develop and oversee delivery of the Executive's overall Recovery Framework/ Plan.
- To ensure that relevant stakeholders are involved in the development and implementation of the Framework/ Plan.
- To establish appropriate workstreams as required.
- To produce an evidence-based status report on how recovery is progressing.
- To co-ordinate the recommendations and actions of workstreams, monitoring progress as necessary.
- To monitor funding as required/agree success criteria and timescales.
- To deal with other recovery related issues that fall outside the scope of the workstreams.
- To ensure the co-ordination and delivery of consistent messages to the Executive, general public and media.
