Priorities

- 3. Action: David Small (DAERA) to liaise with local government today (9 April) regarding more robust data on fly tipping.
- 4. Action: Peter May (DoJ) to liaise with Richard Pengelly (DoH) regarding the guidance and supply of PPE for funeral directors.
- 5. Action: Mike Brennan (DfE) to provide an update tomorrow (10 April) re the challenges faced in the haulage industry.
- 6. Action: ACC Alan Todd to liaise with Chris Stewart (TEO) and Hugh Widdis (DSO) to clarify the legal position on travelling for exercise by lunchtime today (9 April).
- 7. Action: Stephen Reid to provide an update from councils on the effectiveness of park closures tomorrow (10 April).
