Strategy and action plan

They have been through the red risks, with exception of housing [NR] and I plan to meet DfC to understand that better before we table anything).

The strategy and action plan is being noted but isn't driving any new activity or challenge. It is helping to understand risk but not impact.

I'd like to commission a point in time paper to give them an understanding of impact for each project. I'd need inputs from project owners and I've chatted it through with Paul Grocott (who always gives me really good feedback). He's happy and supportive.

Important for the record, but also it has some potential to give a degree of confidence that a lot has been achieved outside of lockdown (things can be done without impacting R). Might also be a helpful “here’s where we are” for the recovery work.

If you are content, I will commission this to go to Executive tail end of next week. It would sit alongside the plan itself.

I’d like to move to fortnightly updates of the plan. If you are content, we would skip this week **NR** as it is an exec document would fm and dFM have to say something about that today? Or is there enough flex on how often the document goes in?).

Cross cutting issues

Still keen to put something in on vulnerable children. Not this week though, to keep the focus on restrictions. Next week maybe, depending on what the data sets look like.

I’m also unsighted on what interventions are there for homeless people so I will talk to DfC about that too. **NR** when we get the meeting on housing, can we ask to have the homelessness lead on the call too please.

Brexit

NR and I are hoping to talk to Andrew and Lorraine this week about scenarios. Paul Grocott is in the same space as us in wanting to shift towards getting business to prepare in the COVID context.

We will need to think about sequencing and balance between COVID, Brexit and other business at Executive.
