I had a useful call with **NR** on the BIC suggestion, and advised him candidly that we see little prospect of it adding value, and that it would add to the DoH workload.

NR explained that SoS remains very keen, and that it would be a 'nations' teleconference rather than a full blown BIC. The objective would be not only to resolve differences here, but also to improve East West communication – NIO feeling a bit put out a not having been notified by Irish colleagues of last night's travel announcements.

I left it by re-iterating our concerns and my assumption of what the DoH reaction would be; and suggested that I could see value only if it was part of a broader 4 nations discussion of 'how and when to close schools (unlikely).
