Life is never straightforward.
Please see the attached English regs, which replace those of last Saturday.
In broad terms they cover

- · Catering premises that must become 'takeaway only'
- · Premises that must close
- Premises that may remain open, but which must configure for social distancing; and
- Severe restrictions on the movement of citizens.

The profound nature of these provisions (which are subject to the confirmatory control procedure) reinforce Tanya's concerns about taking similar action by the route of direction, with no Assembly scrutiny or control.

The more practical consideration is that the regs are complex, and only some parts would appear to fall within the direction making power that TEO will have – the last part could only be replicated in DoH regs.

I wonder whether, even at this late stage, the better route to follow would be to make a single set of NI regs, similar to the attached, rather than to engage in the complex task of unpicking the English regs and splitting them in two.

We could, I am sure, join our forces with DoH and get that done quickly, which strikes me as the best route to giving Ministers assurance that we have covered the bases.
