I believe you and NR were on the line too. Coveney highlighted the tensions on the island of Ireland of not coordinating our responses as we went into lockdown. With two different jurisdictions each with different rates of infection and different appropriate responses, there was a challenge in preventing cross-contamination across the N/S border. CDL emphasised our respect for the autonomy of the DAs but our belief that it was easiest to move in tandem. The same held N/S. 


