The Executive discussed the types of measures which could be put in place to take effect at midnight on 12 November until 27 November.

Points 1-4 reflect that discussion.

With the exception of the points 1-4 below, the current regulations remain in place until 27th November.

- From 13th November close contact services including driving instructors will be able to re-open by appointment and contact details retained (for track and trace purposes).
- Licensed premises will reopen on 27th and a group, involving the hospitality sector and local government will be established, no more than 6 people from no more than 2 households.
- 3. Unlicensed premises such as cafes and coffee shops can open from the 13th Nov but close at 8pm. (No bring your own).
- 4. Pubs and bars will be permitted to sell sealed off sales from the 13th Nov.

Areas of discussion that fall outside of the Regulations as discussed are:

- 5. Financial support continue to operate for eligible business that remain closed (not only those mandated to close).
- 6. The Executive should continue its messaging around behavioural change (wash your hands, wear a mask, socially distance).
- 7. Need for increased visibility of relevant agencies to support adherence to measures.
- 8. R rate and trends will be kept under close review with modelling updated on a weekly basis.
