Scotland - Need to know what funding is available - self isolation payments being announced by Scotland on 12 Oct. Still a lot of uncertainties. Budget generally – need to push hard on clarity from Westminster. NI been told at top end of Guarantee too as is the case with Wales. Irrelevant & Sensitive Two key issues Irrelevant & Sensitive funding for lockdown – try to focus on specific issues at meetings. Irrelevant & Sensitive Timeframe and funding envelope are key but have been overtaken by Covid response. **ISSUES AGREED:** All DAs agreed to keep dialogue continuing as situation evolves.
