	Options: It is vital that this is escalated immediately to Top Level. Normal Sitrep reporting timelines do not apply.
RED	Definition: Issue, Impact or Sector experiencing significant impacts that will not get better without significant intervention. Sector is not functioning at a practical level or at all. At the Top Level, these issues require Ministerial intervention and decisions.
	Threat to National Security, Property, the Economy, the Environment, provision of supplies etc. [Can be escalated, bypassing the IGs for the most immediate issues, copying in IGs.
	Only for those issues that require immediate action by the center to resolve. Usually escalated via the IGs in order to better frame the problem, investigate wider impacts on other Departments or sectors and identify resolution options
	Options: Escalate – Requires Top Level intervention.
	Definition: Issue, Impact or Sector experiencing moderate impacts. Services reduced but functioning; or impacts are being felt but the wider consequences are not yet fully understood; or issues have been identified within the sector that could create major impacts.
AMBER	Action is required to mitigate the worst of the impacts or to find a resolution in the short term. [Can be escalated for action, or for information only – DOCs and IGs must indicate which in order to reduce requests for more information on them]
	Options: Treat, Tolerate or Collaborate – must be articulated in the Sitrep.
	Definition: Sector is functioning as normally and/or within acceptable limits.
GREEN	Minor impacts are being experienced but these are understood. Lower level Operations are functioning within own set tolerances.
