| KEY POINTS DISCUSSED: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minister Swann outlined the perceived lack of progress on this issue, and lack of cooperation from officials in ROI Minister Donnelly suggested AG concerns related to some years back and a previous AG, and had asked officials to engage with the new AG Minister Swann outlined what the information would be used for in NI, including confirmation that it would not be used to enforce self-isolation Minister Swann requested the address for NI passengers be collected and that the ROI PLF be amended to distinguish between NI travellers and transiting passengers. Minister Donnelly asked if NI were considering PDT for intra-UK arrivals and Minister Swann confirmed we were not Minister Swann outlined the utmost urgency of getting a resolution to data sharing, particularly given the number of arrivals to ROI from Brazil in recent weeks | | | |
