KEY POINTS DISCUSSED:		Ministers advised Chief Constable about expected content of Prime Ministers statement to be made later that day (on the evening of 23 March) to increase restrictions related to COVID. Non- essential retail to close and individuals to say at home if possible. Discussed police presence on the ground to address concerns about panic buying. PSNI indicated a matter for supermarkets to consider as well. Legislation to address will follow government advice. PSNI initial focus on engagement rather than use of Fixed Penalties.		
ACTION POINTS:		First Minister indicated she was content to accept an offer of assistance from a PSNI officer to work with the HUB. No actions required as FM and dFM HAD considered the OFFER (which had been made on Friday 20 March) and confirmed position to HOCS on 23 March vis email from PPS FM immediately prior to this call – email attached.
