<b>KEY DISCUSSION POINTS:</b> Meeting convened to consider potential to increase family contact. CMO noted that community transmission will not get any lower, therefore meeting indoors can be facilitated if the Executive wishes to make that decision. There are moderate risks but these could be offset by wider benefits.			

<p>CSA suggested up to 6 indoors, socially distanced and encouraged to wear face coverings. No overnight stays and those shielding would be excluded at this stage. Anyone in a bubble presently would have to remain there – cannot switch from bubble to (up to) 6 indoors. Alternative option is bubbles of two households which carries lower relative risk but could be held as a contingency option if the value of R begins to increase.</p> <p>FM agreed with the proposal and to retain bubbling as reserve option.</p> <p>Karen agreed to consider grouping of remaining issues with planned trajectory over a timeline to end August.</p>
