## KEY POINTS DISCUSSED:

Ministers Swann indicated that Care home guidance to be considered by Executive on Thursday (10 Dec 2020). Message on vaccines is key – optimistic but cautious.

Compliance group meeting tomorrow with JMs. Minister Swann indicated local government was concerned about Xmas markets. JM Kearney also worried about town centres, teachers and Xmas gatherings. Minister Swann noted that if anyone tests positive after 11 Dec they will be self-isolating on Christmas Day.
