<b>KEY POINTS DISCUSSED:</b>  FM – no further forward. Told them 4 weeks, now suggesting a further 2 weeks.  dFM – Junior Ministers had a good meeting with the sector this morning, and they set out a range of measures. A realisation that the situation Indicated  Min Swann – no change from last night. Tests rising again and so are the number of positive cases. Board meeting with Northern Trust, 100% occupancy, tired staff.  FM – paper shared with DoH. A summary of what they should be doing anyway.			

<p>CSA – Welcomed papers. Covid Supervisors. Proposal align with current restrictions. Unconvinced it will make a significant difference.</p> <p>dFM – If we apply another 2 weeks on Hospitality but open close contact what would the impact be.</p> <p>CSA – possible rise in R of 0.05, minor impact if mitigations in place.</p> <p>FM – needs to be more direct engagement with Hospitality Sector as soon as possible to talk to them so we do whatever we do in conjunction with them.</p> <p>dFM agreed. The earlier the better. Trying to avoid coming back to this before Christmas.</p> <p>Min Swann this initial work will push any further intervention further down the line.</p> <p>FM not another lockdown, further</p> <p>Min Swann raised concerns around a legal letter in with DoH and indicated that the Executive Paper is a simple 2 week extension of the current arrangements. Expected later tonight or early tomorrow morning.</p> <p>dFM queried what the paper says about Close Contact.</p> <p>CMO – Not mentioned but could be facilitated.</p> <p>Put paper in as is and have discussion at the Executive.</p>
