<p><u>2 metre distance rule</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ministers are to regulate in the coming days for staff to work to a 2 metre rule. 	
<p><u>Mental Health</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> JD explained that she is seeing a reduction in beds being used for mental health. Her team are looking to put out some guidance to Health Boards on what a minimum service would look like. 	
<p><u>Nursing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A letter has now been sent out to nurses in social care asking for colleagues to come back to work. JW stated that she agreed a joint letter with the UK Government as they wanted to issue it urgently. JW updated the group that she has had contact with Nurse Director's regarding PPE and CPR. 	
<p><u>PPE</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A discussion was held on PPE and specifically on ventilators. The Deputy Minister has held discussions with Ty Hafan as their service users had received a letter from their GP's which said that if they caught the virus and were seriously ill they wouldn't be resuscitated. JW and colleagues are working on the ethical framework. 	
<p><u>Infrastructure developments</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> SSE stated that in the next 24 hours there will be a final list of field hospitals. There have been some negative communications around them. The FM has been really clear on their purposes in the press.
