Very many thanks for copying me into this.

You will appreciate I am only just back and therefore have looked quickly for the first time this evening - given the No 10 timescales I accept my broad comments are likely to be too late.

I do however have some very major concerns. We appear to have a whole data factory arisen from a single primary outcome measure of effectiveness - which is prevention of death.

The only logical way I can see to identify relevant strong interim variables as proxy measures of success for this programme would be if the data being collected could demonstrably be linked back coherently to the model which the SAGE/SPI-M modellers used.

On a very quick skim I can't see that this has happened anywhere.
