People have been talking to us



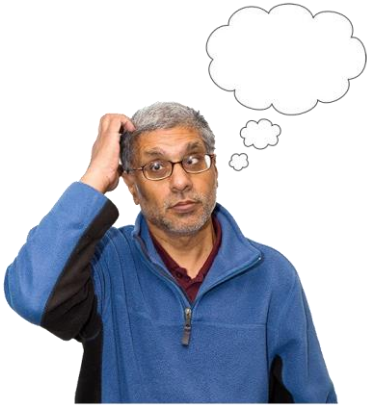

At the hearings, we show artwork which has been made to remember people we have lost. You can see it on our website.

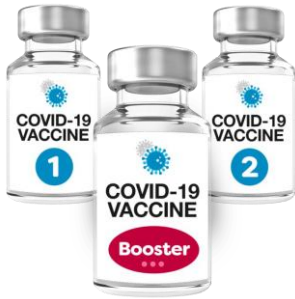

A **vaccine** teaches your body to recognise and fight a virus.



Therapeutics help people to recover from Covid-19 more quickly.
