Responsibilities

Vaccines taskforce

The PM has asked that the Vaxines Taskforce aims to ensure that there is a vaccine that can bring the pandemic to a close as quickly as possible for the entire population of the globe. He has a profound and deep rooted aim that the world be immunised as quickly as possible. The UK must be at the front of the pack in developing and benefitting from such a vaccine. As such the work of the taskforce should be on R&D; building manufacturing capability (plus fill and finish), for the range of vaccine technologies. As well as looking at UK technology, the work will need to ensure that the UK has a stake in and access to a spread of vaccine technologies, including through direct deals with companies and through sponsorship of CEPI and Gavi. In addition to securing access to a vaccine the work should also ensure that the UK builds permanent manufacturing capability for the longer-term. It would also cover antibody therapy given the synergy with vaccine development.
