Thanks for joining the call this morning, I've just been on one of the regular calls we have with the Regional Heads of EPRR and the concerns expressed by the Regional Heads of EPRR have not been addressed.

Ash from the Midlands reported that she had taken a call from the Regional relationship managers **NR NR** who had not been able to provide responses to the concerns she raised and didn't know about the PIP stockpile and the distribution arrangements. I'm advised that WMAS had placed an order for facemasks and that these have not been forthcoming, and that Anthony Marsh (CEO) is escalating to Simon Stevens.

London reported concerns around continuing with community swabbing and access to PPE,

North East & Yorkshire reported that YAS have moved to RPE because of a lack of appropriate PPE, and that Merseycare were suspending community swabbing due a lack of PPE.

South West reported that South Devon had suspended due to a lack of equipment and swabs.

We did discuss the need to have a regional relationship manager for each of the regional incident coordination centres, these people would be ideally based in the Regional Office.
