Upstream Processes – Primarily CE marked and otherwise marked procured PPE	Cabinet Office and Deloitte have been tasked with procuring PPE for the NHS. There are four streams of supply:  • UK new manufacturers (CO Make Cell lead)  • Existing supply chain (NHS lead)  • RoW (CO China Buying Team Lead)  • Donations (CO VIP Team Lead)  Once stocks have been identified for potential procurement they are triaged as CE marked or otherwise. If they are CE marked, and the CE mark is genuine they are procured.  If not CE marked or questions over CE mark downstream processes will be enacted.  CO request approval from the Decision Making Committee (DMC) before purchasing to try and ensure that the product meets all relevant standards and essential safety requirements. This is primarily undertaken through documentation checks.  PPE is also coming in without complete documentation checks.
