(k) COSLA was now participating fully in resilience arrangements led by SGoRR and had offered helpful support for the necessary legislative changes to ensure that all authorities would have the requisite powers;

(l) The police were working together with community groups, particularly people of Chinese origin, to ensure that they felt safe. There were, however, few indications of any coronavirus-related hate crime incidents in Scotland;

(m) All Ministers should be encouraged to look across the range of their own portfolio responsibilities in order to assess what actions could be taken now that might be helpful in mitigating the likely future effects of the outbreak.

20. **Cabinet agreed** that the COVID-19 coronavirus outbreak should continue to be treated as an urgent priority across all portfolios and that all necessary co-operation should be facilitated.
