



#### New UK cases. New reported cases in the UK continue to increase






#### England CC Beds. 36% of critical care beds are currently available in England








Hospital admissions COVID19. Hospital admissions for COVID19 continue to rise








Spare CC beds. Percentage of free critical care beds by NHS region





PPE stock as % of demand. In the best case scenario, stock of four items are reported as insufficient to meet demand











Transport use change. Walking, public transport and road traffic continue to decline







**London transport.** There has been a large reduction in the use of public transport and a smaller reduction in road traffic
















Prison: cases. The number of cases in prisons are increasing steadily







**Pupil School Attendance.** School attendance is well below the 'safe maximum' set out by DfE




