Advice from Public Health England on whether it is necessary for education settings to close:

Even if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19, it is unlikely that PHE would advise a setting to close completely. There are no health reasons why a setting should close unless there is a confirmed case AND PHE local Health Protection Teams have advised you that the setting should close. There are no health reasons why a setting should undertake a deep clean unless there is a confirmed case AND PHE local Health Protection Teams have advised that you undertake a deep clean.

The helpline went live at 12.00 today and we have a steady stream of queries and questions coming in.

DfE Regional schools commissioner teams are in touch with relevant Local Authorities to offer support and further guidance.

The RSC will speak with with any school when its closure is against PHE advice.

For context - there are 3 schools closed under PHE advice and 12 schools (we know of) closed outside of advice. There are 25,000 schools in England.
