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Preparing Guidance in case of failure of supply of Gowns

1. CMO chaired a meeting of the UK CMOs, CNOs, and clinical leaders from NHSE/I and PHE this afternoon to consider guidance to the service on the possible options in case of a failure to supply gowns. This note briefs you on the discussion.

- 2. As you know the supply of gowns is extremely precarious. Immediate needs are being met but there are very limited stocks.
- 3. The meeting concluded:
 - i. A communication to the NHS should be prepared setting out the options in case of failure of supply of gowns. The options to be included are:
 - Use of fluid resistant gowns for AGP
 - Use of non fluid resistant gowns and a plastic apron
 - Use of alternative protective clothing (eg lab coats) and a plastic apron
 - Apron and use of hand/forearm washing
 - ii. If possible the communication should be framed as options for managing stock failures on a range of products to reduce the negative reaction a gown specific communication is likely to attract.
 - iii. We should engage the professions and colleges in the development of the communication. We are planning to do this on Bank Holiday Monday.
 - iv. A decision on when to issue the guidance would be taken after further discussions on whether mutual aid was possible across the 4 nations. We are pursuing mutual aid discussions at official level
- 4. I recommend that you:
 - i. Note the position and our intention to develop options in the event of failure of supply including discussions with the professions.
 - ii. Consider whether you wish to talk to your Ministerial colleagues in the DAs about the current position, the potential options and the possibility of mutual aid.
