1. NHSE presented their modelling work, using parameters from pandemic flu RWC assumptions and also NHSE data on viral pneumonia (see: "20200225 OFF SEN modelling of COVID-19 impact on the NHS – initial estimates DRAFT V3.pptx").

- 2. The committee discussed updates to their modelling and severity analysis on Covid-19 hospitalised cases (see: "UKprofiles.pdf", "CMMID_projections2.pptx", "Agreed RWC planning profile as circulated.pdf" and "CMMID_COVID_meta_analysis.html").
- 3. The committee agreed that, to compare outputs, growth rates/doubling times should be standardised across models and the modellers agreed to use a single modelling profile (see: "Imperial 2.4") for a new COVID-19 specific RWC based on the early stages of the Wuhan outbreak (without interventions).
