Concluding, THE PRIME MINISTER said that the Cabinet had agreed to proceed as set out. This would be welcomed by businesses, the public, and people who wanted to see their loved ones. As these decisions were made, it was important to remember that there were still tens of thousands of new cases each week, and 'R' was still around one. The message was one of gradual liberalisation. Progress had to be cautious to avoid a second peak. Social distancing, self-isolating when showing symptoms and washing of hands all remained critical.
