

This suite of papers covers a potential strategy for the next phase of the response to COVID 19. It follows the first week of conversations between the First Secretary of State, CDL, the Chancellor and the Health Secretary.

The main paper is the **Draft strategy Paper**, which presents: a set of underlying assumptions to test, an initial proposition for changing the social distancing measures, and a set of contingencies to adopt, before proposing a plan for future discussions by Ministers.

It is supported by a series of annexes, listed below. Annex A provides an evaluative framework summarising the estimated impact of the measures against a series of metrics, and annex B is a set of design principles from SAGE. Annexes C-K make up individual fiches for the different types of social distancing measures, providing proposals on amending or maintaining measures in each area, the risks associated with any approach, and proposed mitigation of those risks. Annexes L and M are provided for reference.
