


# **Hospital beds**

Hospital beds is a measure of the number of beds maintained, staffed, and immediately available for use in hospitals for delivering inpatient care.

#### **Definition**

 $Hospital\ beds\ is\ a\ measure\ of\ the\ number\ of\ beds\ maintained,\ staffed,\ and\ immediately\ available\ for\ use\ in\ hospitals\ for\ delivering\ inpatient\ care.$ 

This includes beds that are maintained, staffed and immediately available for use in hospitals. Total hospital beds cover curative (or acute) care beds, rehabilitative care beds, long-term care beds, and other types of beds. The indicator is presented as a total and broken down by type of care.

This indicator is measured in number of beds per 1 000 inhabitants.
